

care.


Here are the seeds I'll plant in

The rain will fall.




The seeds will sprout and grow up
tall.



And packs me lunches that I like.




She always has time to read me a book


Five Little Peas





Earth Day


I Have a Little Frog



Bee




BUZZ! goes the bee,

Let's give a big cheer!


